



## SCHOLARSHIPS

### School Specific Scholarship Process

1. Counselor completes & returns the scholarship selection committee roster form & annual forms (Confidentiality Form & Conflict of Interest Form) to CTF
2. CTF provides a digital copy of the application for each scholarship that applies to your school & county
3. Counselors provide & promote applications to students
4. High School committee meets and makes selections
5. Counselor emails one application, the selected recipient, to CTF at [ctf@ctfinc.org](mailto:ctf@ctfinc.org)
  - a. **CTF School Specific Scholarships- due to CTF by April 15th**
6. Counselor emails the selected recipient's senior picture to [ctf@ctfinc.org](mailto:ctf@ctfinc.org)
7. Counselor informs CTF of date, time, & location of award presentations
8. CTF provides names to Counselors of CTF presenters.

### ALLEGANY COUNTY SCHOLARSHIPS

#### Allegany High School

##### 1. ***Russell Lee Poling Scholarship***

- High school athlete, pledge to not use tobacco or drugs, demonstrate interest in serving in military

#### Fort Hill High School

##### 1. ***Fort Hill Scholarship Funds\*\* see separate page for there list***

##### 2. ***Saiquan Jenkins Memorial Scholarship***

- All applications for the Jenkins Scholarship will go through CTF's Community Scholarship Selection Committee, applications due to CTF by April 1st.
- For football players graduating from FHHS, must have played for a minimum of 2 years, with a GPA of 3.0+

#### Mt. Ridge High School

##### 1. ***Dick Ryan Scholarship***

- Pursuing courses in engineering, basic sciences or mathematics

##### 2. ***"Moose" Arnone Scholarship***

- Must play college sport

##### 3. ***Valley High School Class of '77***

- Recipient must display good moral character, devotion to MRHS and local community. Preferred but not required, that the student be a descendant of a Valley High School alumni.



## **GARRETT COUNTY SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **Northern Garrett High School**

#### **1. *George B. & Lenore Morgan Humberson Scholarship***

- Pursuing a degree in post-secondary education at FSU

#### **2. *NHS Athlete Scholarship***

- Must have played either, football, baseball, or softball for a minimum of 2 years, have a 3.0+ GPA, 90% attendance

## **MINERAL COUNTY SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **Frankfort High School**

#### **1. *“Be A Light”, Payton Grady Memorial Scholarship***

- Pursuing a degree in healthcare

### **Keyser High School**

#### **1. *Guidance Counselors Memorial Scholarship***

- Pursuing a degree in education, preferably in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics

#### **2. *John R. Shelton Scholarship***

- One male and one female that intend to play a sport in college

#### **3. *Jack Tasker Memorial Scholarship***

- Pursuing a degree in the Arts or involved in Soccer

## **Mineral County Student or Current Legal Resident of Mineral County**

#### **1. *Dr. Harry & Mrs. Flo Boggs Study Abroad Scholarship***

- For high school, college, or university students up to 25 years of age who are participating in an academic study abroad program or school sponsored travel to a foreign country. Intended to support academic study, school sponsored travel or research in a foreign country.
- Applications must be received by Feb. 28.

6. CTF informs counselor of community scholarship winner.

8. Counselor informs CTF of date, time, & location of award presentations
9. CTF provides names to Counselors of CTF presenters.

## **ALLEGANY, GARRETT, & MINEARL COUNTIES**

### **1. *Katie & Molly's, "I Run Because I Love It" Scholarship***

- Participated in cross county or distance track events for two years or more, requires one male & one female recipient
- Open to public, private, & homeschool
- (Open to all three counties, including Hampshire)

### **2. *Alexi Don Fratz-Orr Memorial Nursing Scholarship***

- Pursuing a degree in nursing
- Open to public, private, & homeschool

### **3. *Karl V. & Haseleah Kahl Scholarship***

- Despite a significant challenge, the student demonstrates a commitment to or passion for learning and a work ethic such that there is a reasonable likelihood of their success. Challenge may be financial, physical or a learning impairment
- Open to public, private, & homeschool

## **ALLEGANY & GARRETT**

### **1. *Bertram A. Thiel Mathematics & Natural Sciences Scholarship***

- Allegany or Garrett County student with a GPA of 3.5 or better, pursuing an education in the areas of physics or mathematics at an accredited college or university other than Frostburg State University.
- Open to public, private, and homeschool
- One scholarship will be awarded every four years (2028, 2032, etc..).

**NOTE: This scholarship will not be awarded this May of 2025.**



## **2. The Frank H. Eberly Jr. Memorial Scholarship**

- Allegany or Garrett high school seniors who are enrolled in public, private, or homeschool.

### **Guidance Counselor Annual Check List**

- ✓ Update Selection Committee Roster Form(s) for each scholarship and return to CTF
- ✓ Sign Confidentiality Statement & Conflict of Interest forms for each committee member and return them to CTF
- ✓ Make one selection per scholarship and provide CTF with their application
  - Community Scholarships - Due to CTF by April 1st
  - School Specific Scholarships – Due to CTF by April 15<sup>th</sup>
- ✓ Email senior picture of selected recipient for school specific scholarships
- ✓ Inform CTF of date, time, & location of Graduation/ Awards Ceremony
